Jacket/Coat (seasonal)  
Sleepwear  
Extra Pair of Shoes or sneakers  
Rain Gear/Poncho  
Wool Hat (seasonal)  
Gloves (seasonal)

### Toiletries

Soap in a baggie  
Tooth brush & paste  
Towel

### WHAT NOT TO BRING

**NO** Electronic games  
**NO** Fireworks  
**NO** Weapons of any kind!  
**NO** Candy, Gum, or Snacks.

### Camping Gear

Sleeping Bag (-20 degrees)  
Sleeping Pad  
Mess Kit (knife fork spoon, plastic cup)  
Compass  
Scout HandBook  
Pen/Paper

### Optional Equipment

Camera  
Folding chair  
Pocket Knife (Totin' Chip qualified)  
Pillow or sack for make shift pillow  
Cell phone (emergency use only)

**We do not want animals visiting your Scouts tent**

- \* This list is only a suggestion, the key is to not OVER PACK. Your scout is required to carry his gear from the vehicles to the camping site.
- \* For your Scouts safety, **boots must be worn when we depart**. We will be arriving in the dark.
